Eligibility

- 1. Asia Youth International Model United Nations welcomes youth between the ages of 15 to 25 who wish to have experience in conferences or have high interest in global affairs to be the delegates of Asia Youth International Model United Nations.
- 2. All delegates must be enrolled in High School/University, must be High School/University graduates, or must be enrolled in International Organizations/Institutions/Companies.
- 3. All delegates should choose a maximum of 2 council preferences and 2 country allocations.
- 4. All matters regarding country allocation and council preference will be arranged based on the decision of the committee.

Payment

- 1. All fees are **non-refundable**.
- 2. The provision of payment will be informed in the letter of commitment that will be provided by the committee.
